Parental Consent Form

As the parent or legal guardian of the student _____, I hereby give consent for this student to participate in the **Firearm Safety and Violence Prevention Pilot Program** created under section 53A-13-106.5(2) Utah Code, as approved by the district school board or charter school governing board. This instruction is offered to a student in any of grades 5 through 12 and is about:

- (a) Firearm safety, including:
 - a. Developing the knowledge, habits, skills, and attitudes necessary for the safe handling of firearms; and
 - b. Teaching a student that to avoid injury when the student finds a firearm the student should:
 - i. Not touch the firearm;
 - ii. Tell an adult about finding the firearm and the location of the firearm; and
 - iii. Share the information in i. and ii. above with any other minors who are with the student when the student finds the firearm; and
- (b) What to do if the student becomes aware of a threat against the school.

I understand the pilot program shall use materials and curriculum supplied by the provider selected under the statutory criteria, and instruction may be provided on a voluntary basis by:

- (A) The Division of Wildlife Resources;
- (B) A local law enforcement agency;
- (C) A peace officer; or,
- (D) Another certified firearms safety instructor.
